8 Feeder Schools in the Hemsworth Pyramid decided to pool their funding and employ a secondary PE Specialist (Claire Southam) from Hemsworth Academy to come in and help improve the quality of PE & Sport in their schools. The schools involved are Bell Lane Academy, Fitzwilliam, Grove Lea, Havercroft, Kinsley Academy, Ryhill, St Helen's & South Hiendley.

Our Initiative Aims:

To improve the provision of High Quality PE & Sport in Primary Schools by developing staff confidence & the enjoyment of children when teaching / learning and taking part in PE & sport.

To ensure the provision of High Quality PE & Sport is sustainable and achievable.

Our Initiative Objectives:

Put effective plans in place to improve provision & outcomes in & through PE, Physical Activity & School Sport.

What Hemsworth Pyramid have done with their funding

£8000 +£5 per child DFE Government funding for Primary School PE development. This is broken down into two main parts:

- A. **£1,250 approx.** (£1000 + £5 per child) to each school to spend on CPD, specialist equipment etc.

- B. **£7000** to Hemsworth Academy. This £7000 is split into 2 parts:
 1. £5,500 approx. = Salary for PE Specialist to help improve quality & provision of PE
 2. £1,500 = Central pot of funding given to Hemsworth from the 8 cluster schools for transport, facilities, resources, equipment, medals, trophies, certificates, printing & photocopying etc.

Our PE Specialist has:

- Delivered 2 hours of high quality PE to our children & staff
- Run extra-curricular clubs in a wide variety of activities including Change 4 Life
- Established clear development and action plans for each year
- Written lesson plans, programmes of study and schemes of work for all activities for all of Key stage 1 & 2
- Provided CPD training for our staff in a variety of activities
- Set up rewards schemes in PE
- Organised and helped run a wide variety of INTRA & INTER sports events
- Worked with staff in lessons team teaching, doing learning walks and observations to help them improve and also working with them on their own self –review
- Set up a PE Co-ordinator forum meeting every term to improve networking and sharing of ideas
- Helped us achieve the Sports Mark Award

- Got our schools OFSTED ready keeping us up to date with new information
- Help us appoint a subject co-ordinator (where needed) and given them regular guidance
- Completed regular PE Audits to help us move forward towards Outstanding
- Completed regular equipment audits and advised us on what equipment to buy
- Provide a reliable, consistent structure to PE & extra-curricular activities by developing an achievable and manageable programme, and schemes of work that incorporate a wide variety of experiences for all young people including Gifted & Talented & Disabled.
- Show staff how Physical Activity can be used in the whole curriculum through school
- Developed an assessment framework in PE
- Organised training for Change 4 Life Clubs
- Set up Play Makers Leaders Award for Year 5's
- Set up PE noticeboards to raise awareness of PE
- Written a Gifted & Talented policy
- Introduced new activities such as Sitting Volleyball, OAA & Tri-Golf to the curriculum
- Written annual impact statements to provide evidence of what we do
- Runs an Awards Ceremony to reward all the children who have taken part in Sport over the year
- Helped us to win the Yorkshire Award for Sport for upskilling staff
